To be bulk billed, you will need to be a current NCACCH Health Access Card (HAC) holder*. If you don't have a current card,

Present your HAC with your Medicare Card at any of our participating GP locations.

Please ask your doctor if you qualify for discount medications on the Close The Gap (CTG), Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS).
